ABC classes are nearing completion at Bass Haven Yacht Club in Beverly and at Gloucester High School. A *Piloting* course is also underway at Jubilee Yacht Club. An additional ABC course starting May 10<sup>th</sup> at the Marblehead VFW hall is now open for registration. Tentative course plans for next fall include an ABC offering in Salem and, for the first time in several years, *Advanced Piloting*.

Our May 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting will feature supper provided by Kathy Dahlstrom. Guest speaker will be Marblehead lobsterman and professional diver Raymond H. Bates, Jr., who will introduce his new book: "Shipwrecks North of Boston, Volume 2: Cape Ann". Copies of the book will be available for purchase (\$20) and signing by the author. Copies of an accompanying decorative chart will also be available (\$10). Our business meeting will include awards presentations, the annual Auditing Committee report, and presentation of a proposed 2017 budget for membership consideration and vote.

#### NEWS FROM THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

#### **GRADUATION SUCCESS**

Last Wednesday all 14 students in the Gloucester High School ABC class completed and passed their final exams. One additional enrolled student will be taking his exam with the Beverly ABC class in May.

The Gloucester ABC class led by Bob Duncan was the first course offered by the Squadron this spring after the New England Boat Show in February. The Gloucester classes were again held at the High School with the generous cooperation of the Gloucester School District.

In Beverly an ABC class is underway on Thursday nights at the Bass Haven Yacht Club. There are ten students enrolled in the Beverly ABC class with a team of instructors let by Robert Sant Fournier. An additional ABC class will commence on May 10<sup>th</sup> at the VFW Post in Marblehead. The Marblehead ABC will be held on Wednesday evenings and will be ably led by Skip Whittaker and his team of experienced instructors.

Meanwhile in Beverly, our Piloting course is underway on Monday evenings at the Jubilee Yacht Club. The classes, including hands-on exercises are led by Jack Reed assisted by Bill Bonner. There are sixteen students enrolled in this course. Three of the enrolled students have taken advantage of our member discount tuition offer and enrolled as USPS members as well.

Following up on our Commander's message this issue, several of our new Squadron members have joined this year as a direct result of the personal interaction with our knowledgeable instructors in class, membership discounts and our new marketing initiatives.

In general, demand for our classes however, has been lighter this year after the record breaking, award-winning enrollments last year. It appears that this year we are heavily competing for students with the Coast Guard Auxiliary, Mass Environmental Police, and local harbor masters who are also offering several safe boating courses this spring after a year of almost no other competition. Despite the competition however, if we can continue to recruit new members through our courses, the efforts of skilled instructors will prove to be beneficial.

#### DON'T FORGET YOUR VSC THIS SPRING



A Vessel Safety Check of your boat this spring can save you serious time and headaches this boating season. Several individuals who missed getting a VSC before cruises last season reported to us that they were hailed and boarded for lengthy inspections last year. Vessel Safety Checks are free and are an easy and painless way to correct any deficiencies before heading out for that cruise.

Our certified VSC examiners will be visiting and available at many local marinas and yacht clubs this season.
