



AMERICA'S BOATING COURSE®



- This 7-week basic introductory course is for both power and sail boaters. It is approved by the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators and **recognized by the U.S. Coast Guard and the state of Massachusetts** as well as all other states.
- Topics include federal and state navigation rules, required & recommended safety equipment, operating & environmental regulations, GPS, marine radio, boat handling, emergency procedures, hands-on chart work and trailering.
- The course meets at Salem Police Headquarters, auditorium, 95 Margin St., Tuesdays, 7-9 PM, September 12th through October 24th. Successful students receive a **Certificate of Completion** showing they have met the educational requirements for safe boat operation.
- Open to all adults and children over the age of 12 on a first-to-register basis. Cost is \$60 for course manual, plotting tools, and exam. Families may share materials to reduce costs.
- Instruction conducted by experienced, certified officers of the Beverly-Marblehead Sail & Power Squadron a unit of the United States Power Squadrons.
- Register individually on-line to save a seat. Class size is limited.
